Scheduling Updates

- North Conferences & Calgary Conference Scheduling is underway
- Hockey Alberta will identify South Scheduler
- Once identified, will update South associations with deadline to submit ice allocation and contact for scheduling
- Need South playoff tournament hosts to step forward. Will look to create rotation.



Technology Updates

- Website:
 - AA divisions will operate on LeagueStat platform – same as AAA divisions
- Livestreaming:
 - Not in a position to use FloSports for AA livestreaming in 2024-25
 - Teams may use other livestreaming services \
 - Will engage membership to determine livestreaming interest/capability & build plan
- Statistical/Video Analysis:
 - Have engaged Hudl to discuss the offering they can provide interested associations for 2024-25
 - Participation would be optional and separate from league fees
 - Will update members with pricing and plans shortly

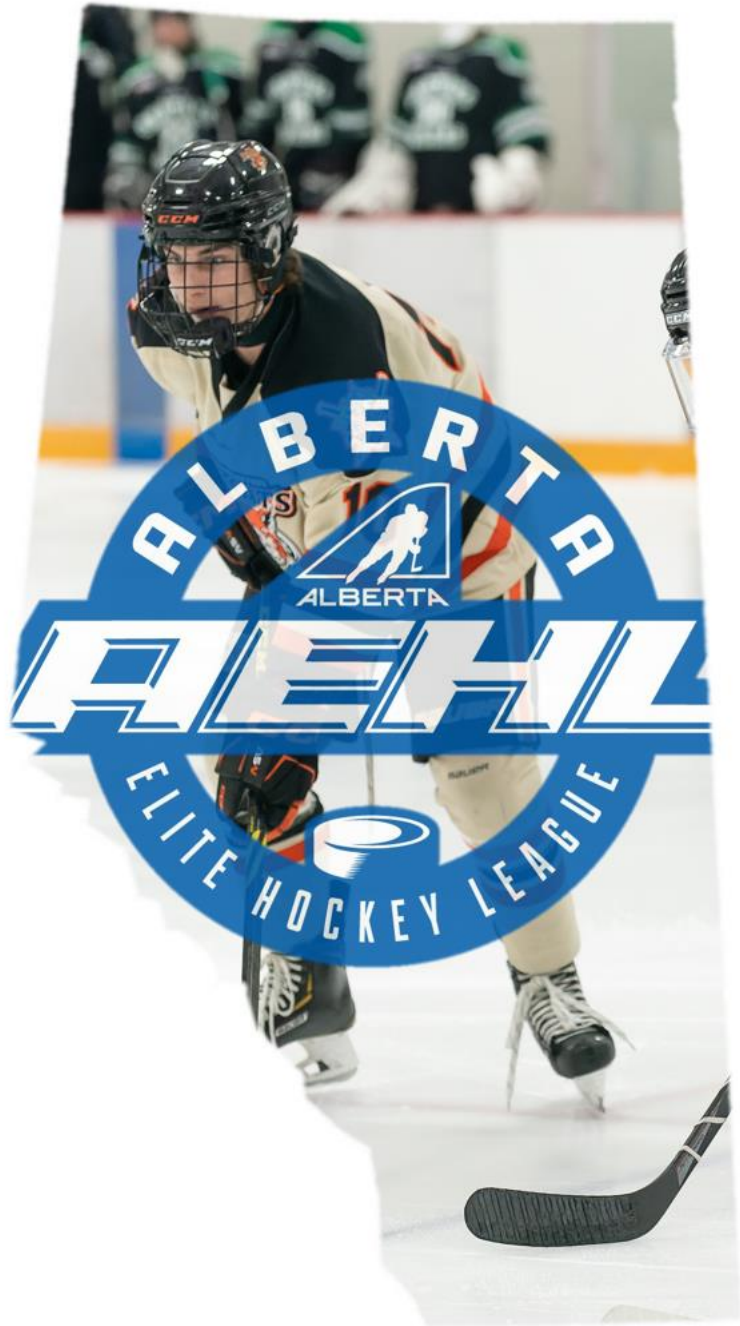
AEHL Patches
